

STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

SALARY SURVEY OVERVIEW



Employers Council was contracted as a third-party data collector to conduct a strength and conditioning coaches salary survey for the National Strength and Conditioning Association in 2018 and 2022.

Participants:

Beginning in September 2022, The Employers Council collected 2,286 responses from current Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist® (CSCS®) and NSCA Certified Personal Trainer® (NSCA-CPT®) certificants in North America. The majority of the participants work in an independent / private setting (652), followed by college or university (475) and high school (225) settings. The 2018 and 2022 Salary Survey data are compared below.

Salary Survey Results:

The information below provides a breakdown of average salaries and percent change by types of settings.

2018 & 2022 ANNUAL SALARY BY SETTING

| Setting | 2018 Average Salary | 2022 Average Salary | Percent Change |

| High School | \$49,037 | \$60,527 | 23% |
| College or University | \$49,286 | \$61,923 | 26% |
| Professional Sports | \$76,772 | \$84,575 | 10% |
| Tactical (Military, Police, Fire/EMS) | \$69,437 | \$68,967 | -1% |
| Independent / Private | \$48,584 | \$61,615 | 27% |
